

Public Statement from the Ibero-American Institute of The Hague regarding the Reschedule of the IV Polyphonic Day of International Justice due to Covid-19

The Ibero-American Institute for Peace, Human Rights and International Justice (IIH) announces the joint decision adopted on March 26, 2020 between the International and European Law Programme of The Hague University of Applied Sciences (HHS) and the IIH Board of Directors, by which the IV Polyphonic Day of International Justice, initially scheduled for June 3, 2020, is rescheduled for June 3, 2021 at the HHS. The reason for this decision is the current health emergency in The Netherlands due to the global pandemic caused by the spread of the Covid-19 virus.
